The Lindner Cube is a self-contained, freestanding room-in-room system that requires no connection to surrounding structural elements. It not only provides an ideal space for retreat but also offers maximum flexibility and creative freedom. In a constantly evolving open office environment, the modular design of the Lindner Cube allows for individual adaptation to user needs and spatial requirements.

Variety of Design Options

The Lindner Cube opens up a wealth of design possibilities with its wide range of wall systems: Glass panels can be used to achieve a high degree of transparency, filling the space with natural light. Alternatively, metal or solid wood walls offer flexible combinations that can be adjusted at any time. Depending on the chosen system, the Cube's sound insulation can reach up to 42 dB (lab value). Flush-mounted or suspended acoustic elements reduce reverberation, ensuring optimal speech clarity.

Additionally, perforated metal ceiling panels provide excellent sound absorption, while integrated LED lights offer comfortable illumination of 500 lux, in accordance with workplace regulations (ASR A3.4).

Sustainability with the Cube solo_N

The elegant glass design, combined with wooden profiles, creates an inviting and high-quality atmosphere. At the same time, the use of wood from sustainable forestry reduces the environmental footprint compared to aluminium profiles. The modular elements of the Cube are easily interchangeable and reusable, which extends their lifespan and enhances sustainability. On request, the wooden elements can be delivered with FSC® certification.

Optimal Indoor Climate for Increased Productivity

The Lindner heated/chilled ceiling ensures a comfortable indoor climate by using radiant heat, which avoids unpleasant draughts. Operated autonomously with cold water, the Cube remains independent from the building's technical systems. The quiet ventilation system is seamlessly integrated into the ceiling and can be continuously adjusted to meet the room's requirements.

Doors Complete the Overall Concept

Various door options are available depending on customer requirements, including frameless glass door panels, framed door panels, and wooden door panels, all tailored to the room-in-room system. For a cohesive design, the doors can be visually matched to the chosen wall system. The dimensions in length, width, and height, as well as the floor plan of the Cube, are virtually limitless.
