Project Description

In the northeast of the New Bund Plaza Business District known as the "second Lujiazui" in Chinas largest city Shanghai, the New Bund Enterprise World covers an area of 255,000 sqm. More than 20 buildings are planned to be erected in this area of the futuristic Pudong district in various functions and different sizes in five construction phases. Over 84,000 sgm of commercial space and nearly 42,000 sgm of living space are to be created. The New Bund Plaza complex currently consists of the buildings including Phase II as well as 29-03 and 33-01. The buildings provide office space for numerous well-known tenants, such as Land Rover or Tiger Gas.

Lindner contributed to this project with heated and chilled ceiling systems in all three parts of the project. 45,000 sgm of the product were supplied for the 42 floors in Phase II and 40,000 sgm on 30 floors and 20,000 sgm on 15 floors of ceilings were installed in 29-03 and 33-01 respectively.
